

M.Tech. Dissertation Viva-Voce Examination – June 2026

The Department successfully conducted the dissertation viva-voce examinations of seven M.Tech. scholars during June 2026. As part of the evaluation process, an internal presentation of the dissertation work was organized on 15 June 2026. The presentations were reviewed by faculty members of the department along with Prof. C. N. Singh, Department of Electrical Engineering, HBTU Kanpur, who served as the external expert. Valuable suggestions and technical inputs were provided to the scholars for further refinement of their research work.

The final dissertation presentations and viva-voce examinations were held on 19 June 2026. To ensure a rigorous and unbiased assessment process, external experts from reputed institutions participated in the evaluation.
