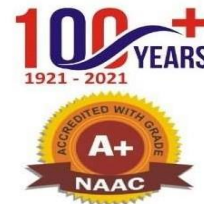
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Report on Expert Talk by Mr. Kamlesh Kumar on Date: 18 August 2025
